Dear Mr. Speaker:

I am writing to you to give notice under Standing Order 52(2) that I will be seeking leave at the earliest opportunity to propose an emergency debate on the Communications Security Establishment Canada metadata collection program.

An Emergency Debate is required in order to allow parliamentarians to study in-depth the extent to which the personal information of Canadians, metadata or other, is being collected by police, law enforcement or national security agencies and to review measures that will result in appropriate parliamentary oversight and reporting of such disclosures in order to balance public safety and national security interests against the privacy rights of Canadians.
